# Better pay and working conditions through collective bargaining

Your union collectively bargains for enterprise agreements to secure better pay rises, allowances and improved entitlements at work, such as personal/carer's leave, paid parental leave and long service leave.

### Industrial advice, advocacy and representation

We provide advice and support in dealing with matters relating to your employment and workplace rights. Where necessary, we represent members in tribunals such as the Fair Work Commission or the courts.

# Assistance with child protection and workplace investigations

Provision of crucial advice and representation during workplace investigations for matters which include child protection allegations, performance issues or conduct and other workplace conflict.

# Return from workers compensation and workplace health and safety

We promote and uphold your health and safety at work. We also provide assistance with the return-to-work process following absence due to workplace injuries. We offer a referral service for advice sought relating to workers compensation claims.

### Accreditation advice and professional development


